EDU 296C + BUNNY LAKE IS MISSING

The next one up in this pantheon of 'media stars' is **EDU 296C**, a Tiger that skipped the motoring press and went straight into films. In fact into a 1965 Hollywood / Columbia financed production called "'Bunny Lake is Missing" staring Lawrence Olivier and directed by Otto Preminger.

To my way of thinking the plot of this whodunnit is pretty dreadful and consequently the film is only notable because of the protracted appearance of the 'bad guy' driving the Mediterranen Blue EDU 296C Tiger around London.

The history record of this machine tells us Humber was the first registered owner from February 1965 but in March 1966 it was sold to a London based advertising agency. Possibly the firm associated with promoting the film.
