T50 NEWS BULLETIN – INTERNATIONAL RALLY January 2014

Dear Guest

We are delighted to be able to present you with our detailed Itinerary for the Tiger 50 International Rally.

During the week-end we invite you to spend time visiting the Tiger 50 Village where all of our Tigers will be displayed and you will find a variety of interesting activities and exhibits.

You will see as you work your way through the Itinerary that two optional tours replace that which was previously entitled **The Nostalgia Tour** during which we had planned to drive past what was once the Jensen Factory in West Bromwich. The reason for the change is that having fully reconnoitred the area we found that there was simply **nothing left** and moreover the famed Kelvin Way is a red route upon which it is illegal to so much as stop a vehicle!

Thus we have decided to offer two alternative tours: the first “**Tigers Roar Tour**” is a drive through the Warwickshire countryside taking in some of the challenging test hills used by the British Automotive Industry; the second “**Coventry Transport Museum**” will be by coach and provide guests with the opportunity to browse the Rootes Group elements of the Museum’s archive and views the world’s largest collection of British road transport. [We did consider convoying to the museum but after lengthy deliberation we decided that taking a large convoy of Tigers into Coventry City Centre via its notorious ring road and then parking them securely was not a sensible proposition!]

So may we ask those of you who indicated your intention to join The Nostalgia Trip to review your choice and let us know whether you would prefer to take The Tigers Roar Tour or the Coventry Transport Museum Tour. Those of you who did not book The Nostalgia Tour but would like to join either of the new Tours may also do so by emailing Dave by the same date.

Likewise we would ask those of you who indicated your preference to join the Shakespeare’s Stratford Tour to reconfirm your intention to Dave Puzey.

We also take pleasure in presenting the guest list *to date* for the T50 International Rally.

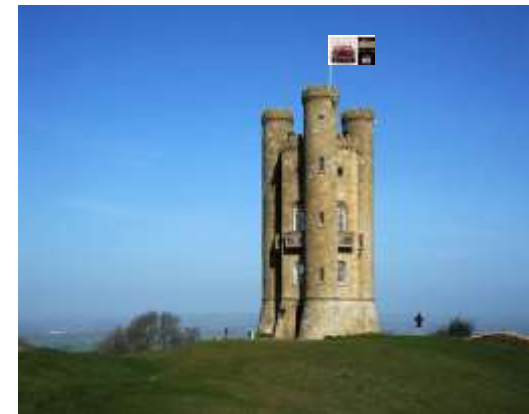
